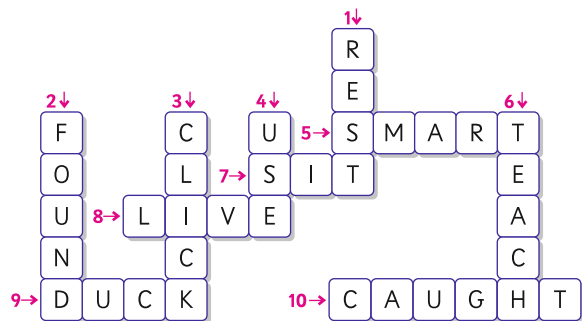

17. Mars Orbiter Mission - MOM

1. The Mars Orbiter Mission is also called Mangalyaan.
 2. It was launched on 5th November, 2013 by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO).
 3. India became the first country to successfully place a spacecraft into Mars orbit in the first attempt.
 4. It entered the orbit of Mars on September 24, 2014.
 5. It took the spacecraft almost 9-10 months to enter the orbit of Mars.
 6. To help Indian scientists gain more advanced knowledge about Mars. It will also help to search Mars for Methane which is a key chemical for life on the Earth.

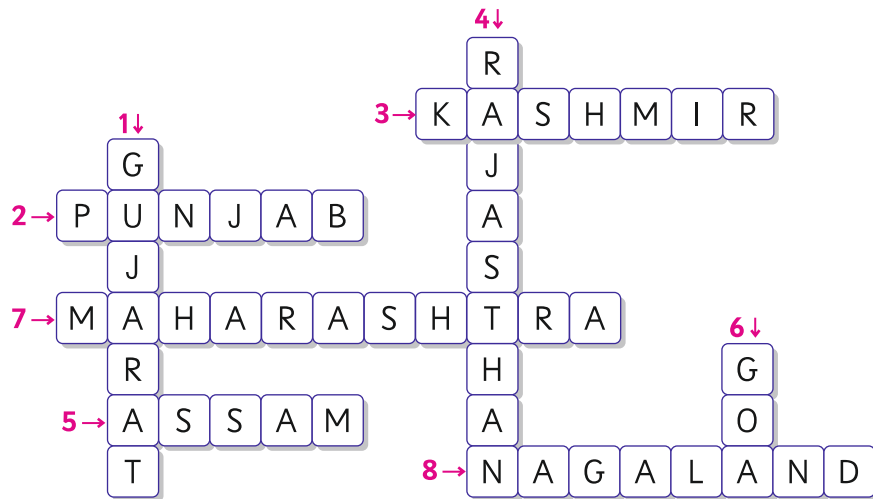

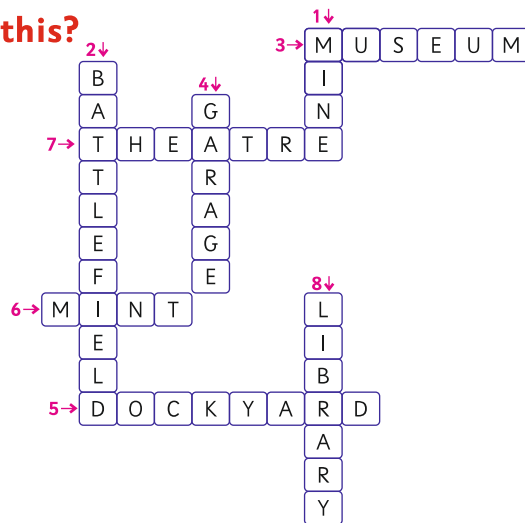

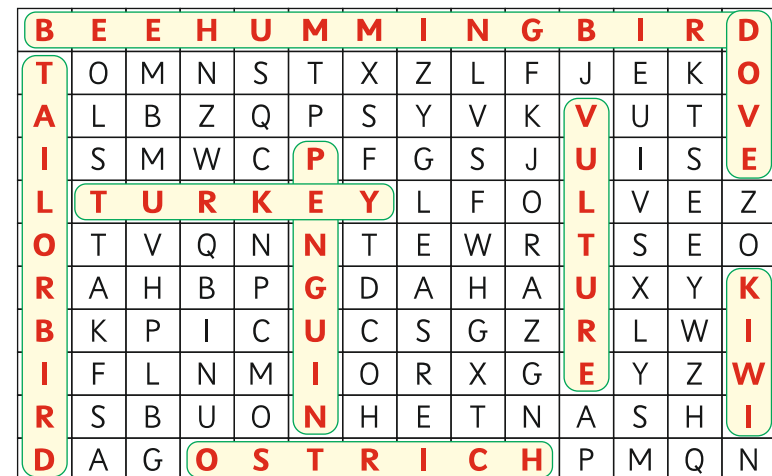
